FLYING POWER stalked the pace from the start, raced along the three path on the last turn then angled outward and rallied late and finished under urging. ALL ACCOUNTED FOR vied for the lead from along the inside through the last turn, then gave way late and finished second best. RUNFORHONOR vied for the lead from the start, raced between horsed through the far turn, then weakened in the drive. H W GOODIE vied for the lead from the three path through the second turn, then faded late. PENNSYLVANIAKING saved ground throughout but lacked a rally. SHARP HEART vied for the early lead, raced along the four path on the second turn then flattened out. BID'S HOIST trailed from the start. HOLY MIRACLE stumbled at the start and lost rider.
