GREAT DANCER was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied late and drew off under urging. IM A TIGGER TOO was close up and three wide on the turn, then finished evenly. AWESOME RUBIANO pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, then weakened late. JERSEY JUMP set the pace from the inside through the turn with a clear lead, then gave way in deep stretch. MITCH'S TWO BELOW was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. PLEASURE BOAT saved ground but was not a threat. HIS MAGIC was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a rally late. NATIONAL PARK raced along the inside on the turn but failed to menace. JOHNNY MAESTRO stalked the pace from along the inside through the turn, then faltered in the drive. BIG MAN SETH pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then was through after a half. MANHATTAN STAR trailed the field.
