MOTHERLOAD HIPSTER was close up, raced four wide on the far turn, then rallied from the outside but drifted in under right handed urging, after a stewards' inquiry and an objection by the rider of DARK CONTINENT for interference, MOTHERLOAD HIPSTER was disqualified from first and placed second. DARK CONTINENT stalked the pace from the start, raced three wide on the last turn, then made a late bid but just missed after being interfered with in the stretch. POLISH DANCE pressed the pace from along the inside through the last turn, then lacked a late response. FOREVER TANGO vied for the lead from the two path through the second turn, then entered into a long drive and faded late. SCHOOL PLAY was slow early, raced along the inside on the far turn then angled outward in the stretch and made a mild bid. IRRECONCILABLE vied for the lead from along the inside through the last turn, then faltered in the stretch. MY LADY A. P. lacked speed, raced two wide on the far turn and showed little throughout. D'LUCCI GIRL was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn and flattened out.
