MAINE INGREDIENT pressed the pace from the start, saved ground on the turn, then rallied late and prevailed. DR. W stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then made a late bid from along the inside to be second best. EURO GHOST was never far back, raced two wide through the turn, then closed ground willingly. CAPIXABA set the pace from the start, held a clear lead while saving ground through the turn, then weakened late. CASANOVA JACK was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. MR. HENRY TWO U raced along the inside on the turn and failed to menace. GOLDEN HALL was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then faded in the stretch. CARINA BAY was close up and two wide on the turn, then was through after a half and outrun.
