SPIKEAVELLIAN stayed out from the rail, gave his best on the final turn but hung. LOVE ON A WIRE found best stride too late. FORT SEATTLE made a mild run outside on the final turn the continued evenly to the end. A. J. 'S CONQUEST stayed out from the rail in an even effort. INDY WORLD trailed.
