PRINCIPATUS was unhurried inside, came out four wide on the final turn while moving, took over approaching the lane and widened under urging. LEXI'S KNOCKOUT chased the leaders while close to the inside then lacked a closing. VALE OF AVOCA lagged early, rallied wide around the final turn and finished with good energy. P FORTY WARHAWK was unhurried, made a wide run on the final turn then flattened out in the lane. GO PA lagged inside then passed tired ones. SWEEP TO GLORY dueled inside then tired. STOLEN PARCEL angled to the inside on the first turn and failed to menace. AMA SOUL MAN wasn't far back early, vied three wide on the final turn then stopped. JERSEY MOJOIE dueled two wide for over six furlongs then stopped.
