BOLD QUESTION ducked out into LIL CHAMP at the break, was sent clear early on the backstretch, stayed out from the rail then drifted steadily through the lane despite steady right hand whip. LIL CHAMP was bumped at the break then moved up between rivals, steadied in tight nearing the turn, raced two wide into the stretch and gained mildly. WILMETTE stayed out from the rail while chasing the winner early then weakened. ALEX'S SIS CASEY was unhurried, was sent closer along the inside into the stretch then flattened out. BLACK MANDATE broke slowly, trailed inside early then found best stride too late. BANKER BAILOUT weakened two wide. JUICY LUCY was wide around the turn and tired. GOOD SONG had early position between rivals then stopped.
