ASK OMMADON was unhurried early, raced four wide on the second turn, then rallied late from the outside and was up in the final strides. KNEBWORTH was close up from the start, raced three wide on the last turn, then contended late and just missed. SILENT TRICK was never far back, raced inside on the second turn, then made a late bid and finished well. MILES HEIR stalked the pace from the inside through the far turn, reached contention late then gave way. KING DARIUS was slow early, raced three wide on the far turn then made a mild bid late. CAJUN BAYOU was void of early speed, raced two wide on the far turn and was never a threat. LONG ISLAND LOUIE set the pace from the start, raced two wide through the second turn then faded late. WINGO (IRE) pressed the pace from the start, raced inside on the far turn, then faltered late. MASTER OF ILLUSION raced two wide on the last turn and failed to menace. THIRD OF JULY raced three wide on the last turn and showed little. ADAMS CIRCLE was close up early, raced two wide on the last turn and faltered late.
