RAPID RAMPAGE was rate two wide in good position, stayed out from the rail once clear early on the far turn and held under urging. NO DELAY was bumped leaving the gate then was rated two wide in good position, came out three wide while moving on the final turn but gained mildly in the lane. TONINTHIRTEEN was bumped and shuffled back at the break then was unhurried while close to the inside, angled out through the lane and was going best at the end. BREWZER was rated inside the winner early, came out two wide between horses on the final turn then weakened. PILOT LIGHT ducked in at the break and bumped NO DELAY, was unhurried inside, angled out in early stretch and made up ground late. I C U DAN was outrun two wide. GELT was outrun. BADGE OF QUALITY stayed out from the rail once clear midway on the first turn, made the way into the far turn then stopped. BREAKING DAWN fell far back.
