**Footnotes**

RESISTING ARREST stalked outside early, moved clear early on the backstretch, angled to the rail entering the far turn and was under steady urging through the lane. ELECTORAL COLLEGE lagged inside, rallied into the stretch then angled out and gained to the end. FAIR CAMMY was unhurried while racing wide around both turns then made up some ground. EARLY EJECTION made the early pace while out from the rail, remained prominent into midstretch then bore out badly under steady left hand whip and faded. BITALIME steadied in tight between rivals entering the first turn, advanced inside on the backstretch, raced two wide around the final turn and tired. HOOSIER STAR came well out from the rail early, remained close to the far turn then stopped.
