MY FRIEND NEV stalked the pace from along the inside through the last turn, reached contention late then drew clear under urging. WAWASET PARK vied for the lead from along the inside through the last turn, was under pressure throughout and gave way in deep stretch. LONGANDSTRONG was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the second turn, then rallied mildly in the lane. CRITICAL ACCLAIM was void of early speed, saved ground on the far turn, then found his best stride late. FLAGGED was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then lacked a rally in the stretch. SEAL TEAM raced two wide on the second turn and failed to menace. TAP TAP I WIN vied for the lead from the start, raced three wide through the second turn, then faded from earlier efforts. PHILLY BOUND vied for the lead from the two path through the last turn, then flattened out in the lane.
