PERPLEXED vied for the lead from the start, raced inside through the far turn, then drew clear late after a long drive. ASTUTEST vied for the lead from the two path from the beginning, then gave way late. DESERT FOX was never far back, raced four wide on the last turn, then made a mild bid late. INVISIBLE GEORGE was close up early, raced two wide on the far turn, then lacked a late response. HE'S A HANDFUL was slow early, raced inside on the second turn, then rallied mildly in the drive. BUCKPASS raced three wide on the turn and was not a threat. DARWIN HILL pressed the early pace, raced inside on the last turn then faded. MR TALC stalked the pace from the three path through the second turn then faltered. MOUNT BREVETOR failed to menace. LANGARTIC lacked speed and passed one late. BENT LEE prompted the early pace, raced inside on the second turn and flattened out.
