DON SEIS vied for the lead from the start, raced two wide through the turn, then drew off late while under urging. CAPIXABA was close up and three wide on the turn, challenged in mid stretch but was second best here. VALUE YOUR ANGEL was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then weakened late. SENOR FANDANGO raced along the inside on the turn and rallied mildly in the lane. LONDON EYE vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then flattened out. C V'S DEVELEN was fractious in the gate, then stumbled at the start but showed brief speed before being outrun.
