HEART OF A LIONESS set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout and finished under urging. HOPEFUL STAR was slow early, raced two wide on the turn, then made a late bid to be second best. MAGIC VISION pressed the pace from along the inside on the turn, then angled outward and weakened late. MALLORYS VALENTINE was slow early, raced along the inside on the turn and lacked a rally. KINGS TUESDAY lacked speed, raced three wide on the turn and showed little throughout. MILLIONDOLLAR DIVA pressed the pace from the two path through the turn then faded. COPY MOM showed no speed while trailing, then was distanced to the wire.
