SKIP THE PAGE stalked the pace from the inside through the turn, then rallied late and drew clear under urging. FIRE AND FORGET vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then drew off in the stretch but gave way late. VICTORY DANCE was never far back, raced inside on the turn, then finished well. DANCE THE WAY HOME was slow early, raced inside on the turn, then found her best stride late. CONTROVERSIA was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied mildly in the lane. WAPOMEO vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faded in the stretch. MS DI PANTOJA vied for the lead from the three path to the turn, then faltered in the lane. WHITE SNOW raced along the five path on the turn and failed to menace. ADDINGBURG was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then lacked a rally. IT'S RING A BELL pressed the early pace, raced three wide on the turn, then failed to sustain a bid. NO EXAGGERATION raced along the four path on the turn and was outrun.
