Footnotes

ANOTHER JOEY was unhurried early, raced two wide on the far turn, then reached contention late and prevailed. LEMON SPRAY was never far back, raced three wide on the second turn, then contended in the stretch but was outfinished. SMILING JORDAN was slow early, raced two wide on the last turn, then finished well. CASE NOTES stalked the pace from the two path into the far turn, then gained command but weakened late from those efforts. FUDGE THE BOOKS raced two wide on the last turn and failed to menace. SPIKEAVELLIAN was void of early speed, raced along the two path on the second turn and lacked a rally. MARION'S MAN lacked speed and showed little. MAKUTUS set the pace with a clear lead while saving ground to the far turn, then flattened out.
