BRILLIANT SON stalked the pace from the three path, reached contention on the turn, then entered into a long drive and prevailed. HADRIAN'S IMAGE was never far back, raced two wide on the turn then angled to the inside, rallied late and just missed. FREE UP GRADE set the pace from the two path, was headed on the turn, then gave way late. COME ON LOVE pressed the pace from the four path through the turn and finished well. KAPER LAKE raced three wide on the turn and evenly throughout. FORESTLEE was slow early, raced four wide on the turn and failed to menace. GOLDEN GATOR showed brief speed, raced two wide on the turn and was not a threat. BRAE PROSPECT saved ground but showed little. PHINEAS pressed the early pace, raced along the inside on the turn then flattened out.
