Footnotes

BELIEVE IN FUN was unhurried early, made a run three wide between hoses into the stretch, angled to the rail for room leaving the furlong grounds then took over inside the final sixteenth. BIG ALAN wasn't far back early, raced three wide between hoses into the stretch, moved to vie on the outside entering the final furlong, held a short lead into the final furlong then gave way. ZIPREME took command at once, stayed out from the rail once clear on the turn then gave way. THE LAST DISCIPLE showed speed from the start, fell back two wide on the turn and weakened. AWESOME CARO had early position then was steadied repeatedly along the rail when caught in tight nearing and for much of the turn then faded in the lane. UNDRGROUNDREGULATR was steadied when in tight between rivals early on the backstretch, made a four wide run on the turn then tired in the lane. WHEATON'S WISH trailed following a slow break.
