**Footnotes**

PEPPERMENTO stalked the pace from the two path on the second turn, reached contention in mid stretch while drifting outward and prevailed at the wire, after a stewards' inquiry PEPPERMENTO was disqualified for interference with FALL SEMESTER, PEPPERMENTO was placed second. FALL SEMESTER pressed the pace from the three path on the last turn, then was carried out in the stretch and just missed at the wire. ONE LESS AFFAIR was never far back, raced four wide on the far turn then finished well. POWERIFFIC was slow early, raced four wide on the far turn and made a mild bid late. VICTORY PLAN failed to menace. DOUBLE DEJA VU prompted the pace from the start, raced three wide on the last turn, then faded in the stretch. FUTURE DREAMS set the pace from along the inside through the last turn then flattened out. FRENCH ACTION was close up early, raced two wide on the far turn then faltered. BOCCHERINI lacked speed and showed little. UPINTHENICKOFTIME was through early and outrun.
