Footnotes

RAIL ROADIE vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, entered into a long drive then drew off while under left handed encouragement. RED RIVER TOCCTET pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, contended late and finished second best. CUVEE AVENUE vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then weakened late. SPECIAL CONGRATS was close up early, raced along the inside on the turn, then angled to the outside but lacked a rally. MY ROAD SCHOLAR showed brief speed, saved ground on the turn and lacked a rally. FIRST CHIP raced along the two path on the turn and trailed throughout.
