ARE YOU SERIOUS pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, contended late then drew clear while under urging. TRIP SIX vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the turn, then entered into a long drive and gave way late. DEANOGUSKA was close up and four wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. ME THE SEA AND G T was unhurried early, raced inside on the turn, then closed ground late. HUNDRED ADAMS was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. FAVORITE FLASHBACK was void of early speed, raced inside on the turn the found his best stride late. AMBROSE LIGHT vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then faded in the stretch. MAGNIFICENT SKY stalked the pace from the four path on the turn, then faltered late. OIL MAN (IRE) lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn, then showed little throughout. PAPALEO stumbled at the start, raced three wide on the turn and was never a factor. TRIP PERMIT vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, the tired late. READY FOR DUTY vied for the early lead, raced four wide on the turn, then flattened out in the drive.
