ASK OMMADON settled, moved to vie three wide on the final turn, lugged in under right hand whip leaving the furlong grounds then was straightened away and drew out late. LION KINGDOM showed inside, fell back on the backstretch, vied two wide between horses on the final turn, was put in tight leaving the furlong grounds then couldn't stay with the winner. IN THE SPOTLIGHT showed speed outside, moved clear early on the backstretch, angled to the inside and gave way. GREAT DANCER was content to lag, made a run well out from the rail on the final turn but couldn't gain through the lane. MENIFEE SIX tired two wide. SIR DYNAMITE tired inside.
