AFRICAN GOLD stalked the pace from the three path from the start, gained command on the far turn and finished under urging. ROYAL JIN was slow early, raced four wide on the last turn, then closed ground willingly. RUN WITH THE TIGER was never far back, raced three wide through the second turn and finished well. DUBAI'S DEBUT was close up early, raced four wide through the far turn, then faded in the stretch. CRAFTY WAYNE was slow early, raced three wide on the last turn, then rallied mildly. OUTLAW CHOCTAW pressed the early pace from the two path, then flattered on the second turn. HOLY MIRACLE prompted the early pace, raced along the inside on the last turn, then faded in the stretch. TANGO RHTHYM set the pace early, saved ground then flattened out on the second turn.
