Footnotes

WIRT lacked room along the inside while behind the leaders nearing the stretch, angled out in early stretch and bumped with FRIDAY MORNING, split rivals and ran clear late. FIELDS REWARD was never far back, moved to vie three wide on the turn, came in in early stretch and helped crowd FRIDAY MORNING then bid but couldn't withstand the winner. Following an objection by Tipa, FIELDS REWARD was disqualified and placed sixth. SECRET MAGIC showed speed inside and weakened. FABLIAN lagged early then made up some ground. JANUARY ANGEL broke slowly and failed to menace. FRIDAY MORNING dueled two wide, bore out entering the stretch then was taken up when squeezed between rivals and stopped. GENERALS'MESSENGER was outrun.
