FOREVER TANGO set the pace from the start, saved ground and led throughout, then finished under urging. DAN'S LAST STAND was close up and along the inside through the second turn, then was no match for the winner in the drive. SCHOOL PLAY pressed the pace from the two path through the second turn, then angled outward at the top of the stretch and weakened in the lane. FORTUNATE SLEW was never far back, saved ground on the last turn, angled outward at the top of the stretch and lacked a rally. FORENSIC EDGE lacked speed, raced inside on the far turn, then passed one late. MY LADY A. P. was close up early, raced two wide on the last turn and was outrun.
