TEMPESTA DI NEVE was bumped after the break then was caught in tight between horses on the backstretch, came out wide on the turn while moving, raced wide into the stretch, took over leaving the furlong grounds and held. MISSISSIPPI MAN was caught in tight between horses on the backstretch and into the turn then came between horses with a late run. CITIGAMBLER was slow early then made a late run between rivals. YONABREWSKA was caught wide while not far back and lacked a strong closing. PATRON SAINT was caught in tight along the rail on the backstretch, gave his best into the final furlong then flattened out. ARPLEASURE advanced outside early, had position three wide into the stretch then weakened. SHAMELESS RISK lagged after a slow break. DOUBLE DOWN VINMAN was bumped leaving the gate then moved between foes to gain the early lead and tired. SUBTITLES ducked in leaving the gate then failed to menace. GUS WHO pressed the issue two wide to the stretch then tired.
