TEN TUTUS was unhurried while outside on the backstretch, began a run between rivals on the final turn, awaited room while trying to split rivals approaching the stretch, followed MASSONE'S ANCHOR through foes then drew off after five furlongs. MASSONE'S ANCHOR had early position inside, fell back on the backstretch, advanced the three path between rivals on the final turn, was clear in early stretch but was little match for the winner. HOOSIER STAR had early position three wide between rivals, launched a mild wide bid on the final turn then tired. SEXY AND SASSY was shuffled back from between rivals entering the first turn, was sent to a short lead from the outside before a half, drew clear into the far turn, angled in to be out from the rail and tired in the lane. DABA DABA DEW was unhurried, steadied in tight midway on the backstretch then tired. ARRHYTHMIC was outrun. BWANA MISS showed speed while caught wide around the first turn, remained prominent to the far turn then stopped. VINOTECA stopped inside.
