Footnotes

THINKING OF GIRLS stalked the pace from the two path, reached contention on the turn, then drew off late while under encouragement. BURNING MANDATE set the pace with a clear lead, raced along the inside and was headed on the turn, then gave way in the drive. CALL FIRST pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then lacked a rally in the drive. VARBOROUGH was unhurried early, raced along the two path on the turn, then made a mild bid late. UNCLE CARM pressed the pace early, raced three wide on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. SLEEPING TIGER was close up early, raced along the inside on the turn, then faded in the stretch. ROCKY ROMANO was void of early speed, raced along the four path on the turn, then failed to menace. TYZACH lacked speed, raced along the inside on the turn and was not a factor. RIOPELLE also showed no speed, raced two wide on the turn and trailed throughout.
