EAGLE BEAGLE was never far back, raced inside on the far turn, reached contention late then drew clear under urging. BILLYSBENORMAL was unhurried early, raced three wide on the last turn and advanced steadily for place. BLAZING BENTLEY vied for the early lead, drew clear on the backstretch then was headed on the far turn and gave way. SIR TOM saved ground but lacked a rally. S. S. SINATRA vied for the lead from along the inside to the far turn then faltered. MY BOY ANTHONY was never a factor. ELMCROFT lacked speed and showed little. A. P. SLEW was close up early and flattened out on the far turn.
