Footnotes

GONE AWESOME stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, contended in mid stretch then prevailed at the wire. BOCCE BALL was never far back, raced four wide on the turn, then closed willingly and just missed. HE'S APPEALING pressed the pace from along the inside through the turn while racing evenly throughout. FORMAL ARGUMENT vied for the lead from the start, raced along the two path through the turn, then gave way in the lane. MAKE A GRAND vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then weakened in the drive. ROCKINANRACIN raced two wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. RED WOOD DEVIL lacked speed and showed little throughout. FAUTLESS LIGHT was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then flattened out in the stretch.
