**Footnotes**

SPIKEAVELLIAN was unhurried early, raced three wide on the second turn then drew clear late and finished under urging. SIR RAY set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout and weakened late. LEAGLENOTE pressed the pace from the two path into the second turn then lacked a late response. ALEDO MONARCH was void of early speed, saved ground and made a mild bid late. FASTIVIST was slow early, raced two wide on the far turn and passed the tired ones. TOUGH AND EASY was close up early, raced inside on the last turn then faded. MARTINS POINT stalked the pace from the three path into the far turn then tired. QUAKER BOB was four wide throughout and failed to menace. GERIHATTRICKS was never a threat and was outrun.
