PU DEW stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, reached contention in mid stretch then prevailed under urging. BARONESS KAYAH was slow early, raced four wide through the turn, then closed ground willingly from the outside and just missed. SILENT SKY set the pace from the start, saved ground through the turn, was headed in mid stretch then gave way. DUAL POWER was never far back, raced along the inside through the turn and evenly throughout. ELEFThERIA was close up and two wide on the turn but lacked a rally. WINNING LINE was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. BROKER'S RISK pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn then faded. HARMONY EXPRESS raced two wide on the turn and was never a factor. NAVAJO SLIPPERS stalked the early pace, raced inside on the turn and was through after a half. GRANNY MAC pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then flattened out in the stretch.
