CARELESS TEASE stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, then drew clear and finished under urging. EQUULEUS was never far back, raced three wide on the turn then made a mild rally. EIGHTY ONE SOUTH vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the turn then gave way. BUGGINS was close up and inside on the turn, then lacked a late response. TALKING ROSIE pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then failed to sustain her bid. GEECHEE was slow early, raced three wide on the turn then made a late bid. SILLYPHILLYSLILSIS vied for the early lead, raced along the inside into the turn then faded. NIGHT IN THE CITY was three wide on the turn and not a factor. U S'S MISS JOYCE showed good early speed, raced four wide on the turn then faltered. MYSTERY WOMAN was two wide on the turn and not a factor. GLORIOUSGAL was not a threat. SUDDENLY SPANISH trailed the field.
