**Footnotes**

BREATHTAKINGBREEZE broke sharply and drew clear early, raced along the two path through the turn, then was ridden out to the wire. DELIGHTFUL DANA was slow early, raced along the two path on the turn, then closed ground late and finished second best. MARIPOSA ROSA pressed the pace from the start, raced along the two path through the turn, then weakened late. SQUARE GROUPEE was void of early speed, saved ground through the turn, then made a mild bid late. HOUDINI'S BLUFF was close up early, saved ground on the turn, then faded in the stretch. LADDER TO THE MOON was slow early, raced three wide on the turn and was through after a half to be outrun in the drive.
