MYERSROCKS was close up and two wide on the turn, then angled to the outside then rallied late and was up in the final strides. GRAND MACHO vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the turn and was outfinished after a long drive. DOUBLE HOLIDAY vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then weakened late. LITTLE PEP was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. RODERICK vied for the lead from the two path through the turn then faltered late. HIGH SUCCESS was close up early, raced inside on the turn then angled outward but tired in the lane and was outrun.
