### Footnotes

WP TOUR went up along the inside to make the lead after a quarter, set the balance of the pace and prevailed under mild urging. WOODSTOWN unhurried early, slipped through along the rail with a quick move entering the stretch, rallied steadily and finished second best. TURNER FALLS allowed to settle, found her best stride too late outside. TIGER DANCER had a mild late rally. TWENTY CENT PIECE well placed, loomed boldly along the rail nearing the quarter pole then came up empty. VALIANT RACHAEL broke in a tangle, went up to vie for the lead three wide, was a sharp threat until mid stretch then gave way. HOLDEM'S SUSIE B. was through after a half. DUAL POWER offered little. LITTLE CHEYENNE was always outrun. BEFITTING away alertly, set the pace for a quarter then stopped.
