MARK UP TINY vied for the early lead, saved ground and drew off on the second turn and finished under steady encouragement. PEACHES MY DEAR was slow early, then rallied from along the inside on the second turn and finished well to be 2nd best. READ RICHIES NOTES was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn then lacked a late response. WILMETTE was void of early speed, raced two wide through the last turn, then lacked a late rally. ENGLISH SPIRIT pressed the pace from the two path through the far turn, then faded in the stretch. MALIBU CITI lacked speed, raced three wide on the second turn and failed to menace. ASIAN DREAM vied for the early lead, raced along the inside on the last turn, then flattened out in the lane.
