### Footnotes

SOPHIA'S SO SASSY was rated between rivals while racing well out from the rail, moved clear when ready entering the stretch and widened under urging. COUNTRY CHIC was caught wide while unhurried around the first turn, made a wide run into the far turn to vie then weakened in the lane. LITTLE E'S THUNDER raced outside the winner for about six furlongs then tired. CLASSIC TEN stayed well out from the rail while making the pace to the far turn then tired. BLACK MANDATE wasn't far back along the rail to the far turn then stopped. MOSTLY LOVE stopped. FRONT STREET was eased after the saddle slipped.
