TOMORROW'S TALE had position inside, was steadied in tight leaving the backstretch, came out two wide between horses, was steadied in tight between foes approaching the stretch, rallied to the front from the inside in early stretch then drew out under brisk urging. IL DIVO rallied four wide to a short lead just after a half then weakened in the lane. INDIANSKI settled, rallied four wide around the turn to get closer in early stretch then flattened out. MANHATTAN RIDGE was bumped leaving the gate, raced wide around the turn and finished willingly. WILD AND TRUE was unhurried, came out between horses on the turn, made a run into the stretch but failed to sustain. PLEASURE BOAT lagged early, raced two wide between horses into the stretch, angled to the inside and made up some ground. CROCKEFELLER set or forced the pace two wide for about five furlongs then tired. YOUNG TROUBADOR was bumped lightly at the break then was outrun three wide. SMART HUMOR was caught in tight three wide between horses nearing the stretch then tired. STRENGTH was outrun. TEMESCAL CANYON came in leaving the gate, dueled between horses into the turn, angled to the rail then stopped.
