### Footnotes

SMOOTH TALKIN' MAN set the pace around the first turn, was briefly headed, regained command, set the balance of the pace while nicely rated and won as much the best. JOHANNESBURG PLACE with the second flight along the rail, got through entering the stretch and finished second best. WHITE BALANCE also with the second flight for six furlongs, had a mild late rally three wide. EPIC EMPIRE unhurried early, offered a mild bid on the second turn and finished with good courage. PHOR PHILIPPE lugged out coming out of the first turn, had speed for six furlongs then gave way. MORE WAYS THAN ONE was outrun. TOM'S TUITION was no factor. BLU THEM AWAY had good early speed, led briefly just after the first turn, remained a sharp threat into the stretch then tired. DOOMER vied for the lead three wide into the stretch then stopped. MISTER ROY (ARG) offered little.
