LITTLE PAPER BOAT broke in full stride to set all the pace and maintained his advantage under brisk handling. GAARA pressed the pace three wide and finished second best. RICHER GEAR never far back four wide, had a mild late rally. TORMENTO DE ORO went evenly. ST. SYLVANS was bumped at the start then failed to reach contention. HIGHEST VALUE close up early along the rail, gradually weakened. RUN JICKSTER RUN failed to menace. STABILITY stumbled at the start, bumped with ST. SYLVANS causing his rider to lose his left iron, he got back in quickly then failed to reach contention. VICTORY STYLE was through early. DIAMOND ACCOUNT had brief speed. GOLDEN ARCHER offered little.
