FAVORITE CARD angled outside while unhurried early, rallied three wide around the turn and drew clear from the outside past midstretch. KALEIDOSTAR set or forced the pace two wide into the final sixteenth then was little match. BIG MAHOGANY raced two wide and lacked a strong closing. BILLY BELMONT was unhurried two wide then made a belated run outside. THIS BULLS BACK stayed inside in an even effort. KING DISCO dueled inside for over five furlongs then tired. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION was no factor.
