NAVAJO SLIPPERS stalked the pace from the two path, gained command on the turn and finished under strong encouragement. CALLED AN AUDIBLE was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. DUAL POWER was slow early, raced along the inside through the turn, then found her best stride late. BLOWN was void of early speed, raced two wide through the turn, then made a mild bid late. ELEFThERIA raced two wide on the turn but lacked a rally. SILENT SKY pressed the pace from along the inside through the turn then faded. CINDYRELLA was close up early, saved ground on the turn, then faltered in the lane. KINDA KINDA raced three wide on the turn and showed little. PERFECT ANGEL set the early pace while saving ground, then was through after a half and outrun.
