GALLANT GULCH vied for the lead from along the inside through the last turn, then drew off late while under urging. BLITZENSKISSINQPID was never far back, raced along the four path on the last turn, then made a late bid to be up for place. GREG GOT EVEN was unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. BEENIE pressed the pace from the three path through the second turn then weakened. J T MORGAN was slow early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then made a late bid and tired. PARADE FOR PEACE raced along the inside on the last turn and failed to menace. TRES DANGEREUX lacked speed, raced three wide on the second turn and showed little. CAPRIDGE vied for the lead from the two path through the second turn then faltered. CASE NOTES was through after a half, raced three wide on the far turn and was outrun.
