MAGIC WAGON vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then drew clear in the stretch and just lasted while under urging. PLATINUM SANDY was close up and inside on the turn, angled outward and rallied late just missing at the wire. BROOKLAWN DOUBLE pressed the pace early, reached contention from the three path on the turn then weakened late. URAGREATAMERICAN was slow early, raced three wide on the turn and advanced steadily throughout. GETTEM READY EDDIE vied for the lead from the start, raced along the four path through the turn, then gave way in the stretch. GRANITE DUST vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then weakened late. LOVE THE WEST was slow early, raced two wide on the turn and lacked a rally. VENTO ARCTICO was void of early speed, raced inside on the turn and was not a threat. SNOW JOB vied for the early lead, raced two wide on the turn, then faltered in the stretch. PA CRUISER raced along the inside on the turn and failed to menace. BULLS DYNAMITE was through early, raced two wide on the turn and showed little. THANK YOU IAN saved ground but trailed the field.
