**Footnotes**

SURPRISE INSIDE pressed the pace from the two path through the last turn, then rallied late to be up in the final strides. SPIKEAVELLIAN stalked the pace from the three path through the second turn, gained a late advantage but was outfinished. DOING AN ED was slow early, raced two wide on the far turn, then closed ground willingly. VILLAGE BAND was never far back, raced inside on the far turn, then lacked a late response. BLOND ACTOR vied for the lead from the two path through the last turn then weakened in the drive. CASE NOTES stalked the early pace, raced two wide on the far turn, then tired from those efforts. SUVOROV failed to menace. STEAMROLLER BLUES passed one late. RANGER CREEK vied for the early lead from along the inside and was bearing out the entire race.
