### Footnotes

BARDI'S AT NOON set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout and finished under steady encouragement. IN THE SPOTLIGHT pressed the pace from the two path through the last turn but was no match for the winner. GREAT DANCER was slow early, saved ground on the far turn then made a mild bid late. MENIFEE SIX was close up but dropped back early and was not a threat. SPIKEAVELLIAN raced along the inside through the last turn and failed to menace. SENSEI BILL lacked speed, raced two wide on the last turn and was outrun.
