MARIAS GOLDEN ROSE was rated out from the inside, moved to vie outside into the final furlong and edged clear after a mile. GRACIES CHOICE was slow to settle, raced two wide between rivals around the final turn then finished gamely. JOEPAUL'STREASURE trailed early, swung wide into the stretch and finished fast outside. SHY BABY showed speed from the outside, opened a clear lead after a quarter, remained out from the rail into the stretch and faltered. EAGLE'S SONG offered a mild bid inside in early stretch then flattened out. WESTERN BELLE raced wide around the final turn and lacked a strong closing response. THE COLOR RED wasn't far back two wide then tired. MISTY SUNRISE was outrun. DIAMOND LAUR stopped.
