SILLY MONEY set the pace from the start, saved ground and led throughout, then finished under urging. NEO'S GRAND FINALE was close up and two wide on the turn, then was no match for the winner in the drive. KINGS TUESDAY was unhurried early, raced three wide on the turn and made a mild bid late. PAST DISPUTE pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then faded late. LANGFURS ANSWER was close up early, raced inside on the turn then faltered in the stretch. SKIPPYS GATOR saved ground but trailed throughout.
