Footnotes

HYMN NOTE was rated outside within easy striking, moved to vie three wide early on the far turn, was clear in early stretch and held under urging. PRINCESS OF HARLEM stayed out from the rail but lacked room behind the leaders on the backstretch and for much of the second turn, swung out entering the stretch, vied outside the winner before a mile but hung. LANGCITA was caught in tight between rivals on the backstretch and for much of the final turn, swung out entering the stretch and lacked a closing. T. M.'S TREASURE lagged the rail then found best stride too late. FOR REAL TOO stayed out from the rail while making the pace for over six furlongs then tired. PURE STRIKE was outrun outside. MERRYLAND MOON pressed the early leader outside, bolted nearing the stretch and was eased up.
